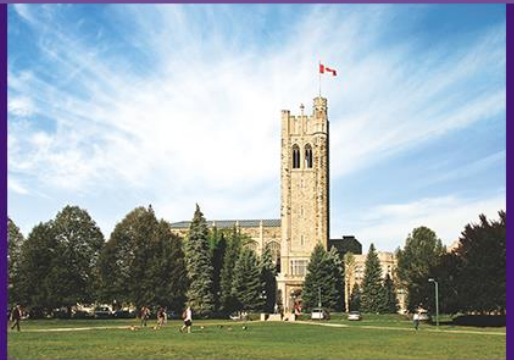

Location

Schulich School of Medicine & Dentistry at Western University in London, Canada. With a population of 350,000, London has many of the conveniences of a big city as well as the friendliness and appeal of a smaller center. London is a safe city that comes to life in the summer with many parks, festivals, and cultural events. It is situated a 2-hour drive from both Toronto and the USA border, making it an ideal location for students to explore nearby sights.

Requirements

Qualified and motivated international undergraduate or graduate students who have completed at least 2 years of undergraduate study in a relevant degree program. Intermediate English language skills.

Dates

2-week program from July 3-14, 2017

Students will have the option of participating in an additional week of training from July 17-21 that will include clinical observerships in a hospital environment and tours of health research laboratories on campus.

Deadline

Application due April 30, 2017





Theme

This year's theme is **Introduction to Global Health**. Students will look at global health from a multidisciplinary and multi-professional perspective. They will receive a high-level overview of global-health-related topics with the overarching goal to develop a broader understanding of major clinical and public health issues around the globe. Some topics include:

- Epidemiological transition and global burden of disease
- Epidemiological methods and study design
- Social determinants of health and neglected populations
- Leadership in public health
- Global health policy & systems research

Accommodation

Summer program students will live in residences on campus. Both single and double rooms are available.

\$500 CAD – Tuition, on-campus activities and bus pass.
 An additional \$250 CAD fee will be charged for those participating in the three-week program.
 \$660 CAD – Accommodation

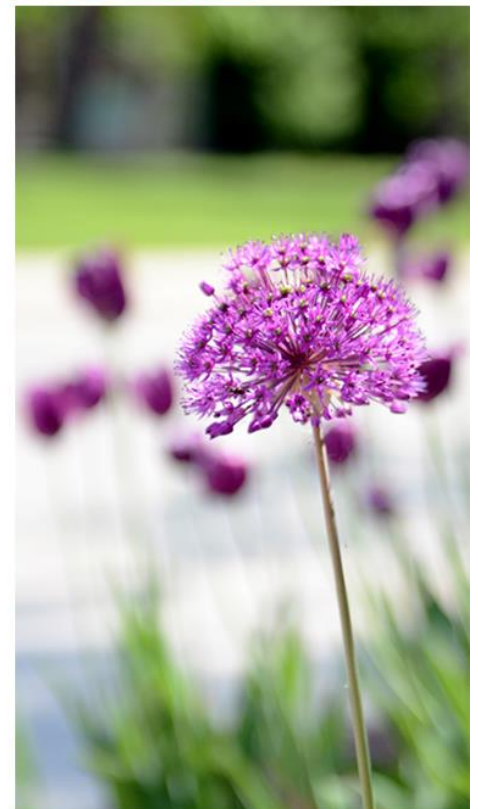

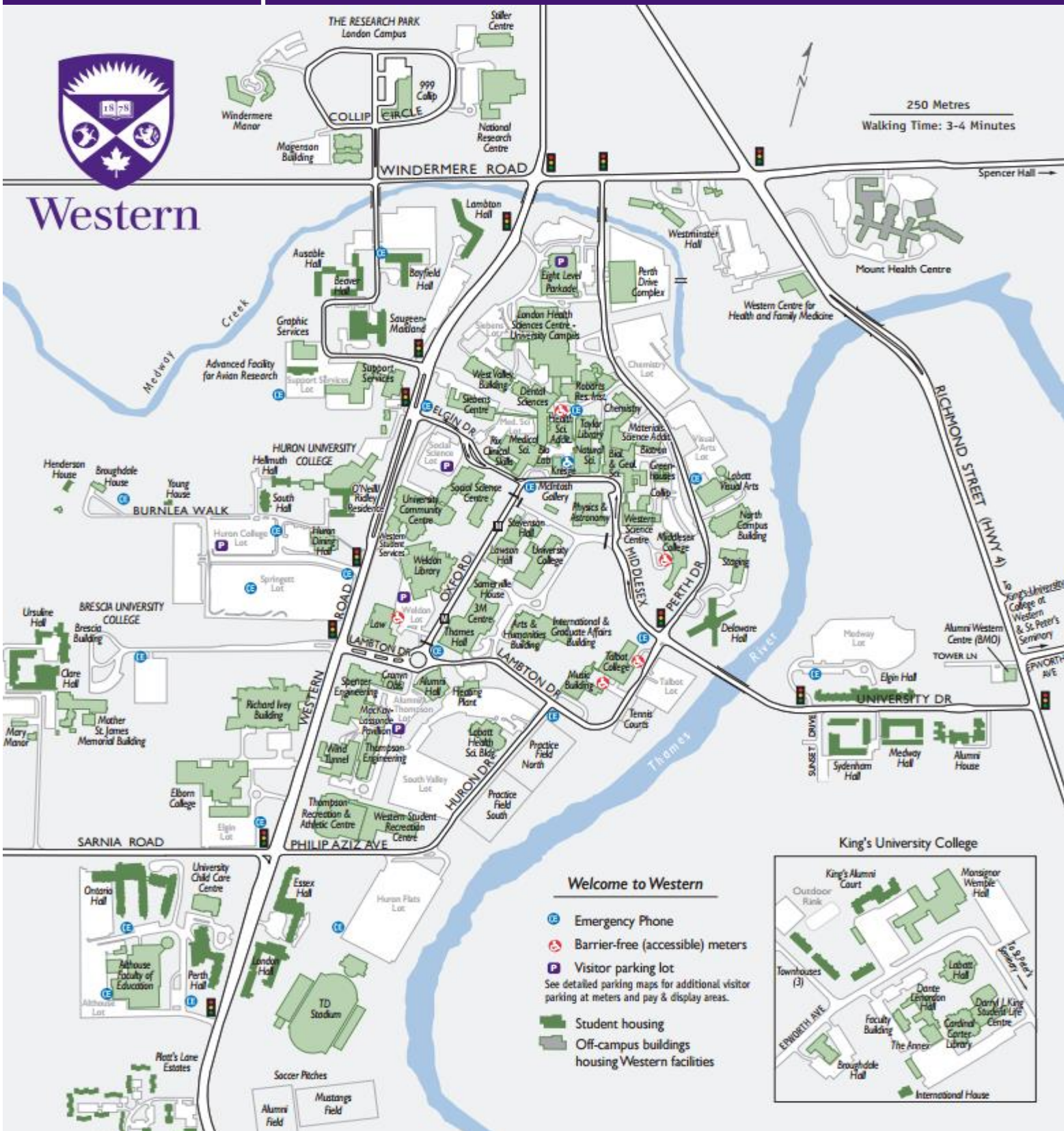




Campus Map
