

The Wilson Medical Exchange

In honor of Robert Wilson, the American doctor who stayed in Nanjing to help Chinese people during the 1937 Japanese invasion, the Wilson Medical Exchange is a three-week program in the United States designed to develop Chinese medical students **professionally** through shadowing doctors at hospitals, **culturally** by living in American homes and **personally** through leadership discussions and volunteer service.



Requirements

Program participants must:

- be a third-year or above undergraduate medical student, or a postgraduate.
- have an upper-intermediate English level or higher.

Application Process

- Fill out an application and submit it by October 21st.
- Those qualified for further consideration will be interviewed in early November.
