



The Wilson Medical Exchange

In honor of Dr. Robert Wilson, the American doctor who stayed in Nanjing to Chinese people during the 1937 Japanese invasions, the Wilson Medical Exchange is a three-week program in the United States designed to develop Chinese medical students **professionally** through shadowing doctors at hospitals **culturally** by living in American homes and **personally** through leadership discussion and volunteer service.

Requirements

Program participants must:

- be a third-year or above undergraduate medical student, or master-level or doctor-level students.
- have an upper-intermediate English level or higher.

Application Process

- Fill out an application and submit it by October 31, 2014.
- Those qualified for further consideration will be informed for the interview.
